Get Ready for Floyd Co. Women's REC #1

Years of prayer has finally been answered. We are going to get to have our first women's REC weekend in Southern Indiana.

The Floyd County Sheriff has agreed to let us have our first Women's REC on the weekend of August 16-19 of this year. Floyd County doesn't usually hold as many female residents as some of the other jails in our area; so, **Lay Director Polly Ash** is preparing for as few as five or as many as thirty. Regardless of the numbers the blessings will be infinite.

We know that Satan doesn't waste a lot of time and effort fighting something unless it will be very powerful for Christ. And, he has fought this hard, placing obstacles at every turn; but, as always Jesus found the way to victory.

Why, you might ask, is a women's REC so important? The answer lies in the structure and dynamics of a typical offender's family.

Most female offenders are mothers. And, the mother is the head of nine out of ten offender's households. Statistics show us that the

Beyond REC

As should be expected we, as a community have experienced growing pains adjusting to the different needs of the participants of REC's. The most obvious is that, since most of them are not in a position to attend our Gatherings, we must take our Gatherings to them.

In case you didn't know each REC team is expected to hold monthly follow-up meetings for the six months following the original weekend – or until all the Residents from that weekend have been released. This is our first line of aftercare for those who God has given us.

Right now we have monthly follow ups for Madison REC #12 on the 3rd Monday of each month leaving here at 6:00 p.m. (EDT). And the Floyd County REC #2 group goes back on the 3rd Saturday of each month at 6:30 p.m. (EDT). Due to the serious over-crowding and under-staffing at the Clark County Jail monthly follow-ups there have been cancelled.

If you would like to take part in one of these

children of offenders are **eight times more likely** to end up a perpetrator in the criminal justice system than the children of non-offenders.

If we can introduce the mothers to the reality of God's love and mercy we have a chance at reaching the children before it's too late. Then the Kingdom is blessed by both mother and child.

Besides, well over half the DaySpring Community is female and has rarely had the opportunity to experience the power and emotion of an REC. This is our only program designed specifically to lead lost men and women to Christ; and, sometimes the tears of joy are simply overwhelming.

Watch for details as we get closer to our first women's REC weekend. Make plans to attend the Candlelight, get your Sunday School class or Reunion Group to prepare Wheat Letters or serve breakfast to the team and really spend time on your knees praising God for this new ministry and asking his guidance and protection for the team and the residents.

follow-up meetings you would be welcome even if you weren't one of the original team members. In fact, if you had considered working an REC team and just wanted to "test the waters" this would be a wonderful opportunity, with no obligation.

As is our policy in all such matters only men attend the follow-ups for men's REC's and women attend the women's follow-ups.

Early in the planning of this weekend God put a special burden on me to provide access to Spanish-speaking Residents who might choose to attend. All our weekends are based on the "Cursillo" model, which was originally entirely in Spanish; so, this seemed like a logical direction for us to go, since there are almost always Residents who speak very little English – and because God said so. So our *Single Life Talk* will be in both English and Spanish; and, we will post fliers and have applications in both languages. We have not found a Spanish-speaking Table Leader; but, we are still looking and still have an open place on the team.
