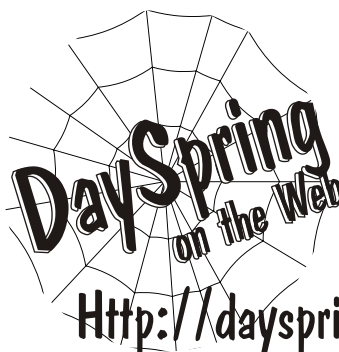
It's Time for Cornerstone Teen Chrysalis 27

You have probably noticed a lot more attention given to DaySpring's "Residents Encounter Christ" ministry in the newsletters over the past year. That is because, during the past year, this ministry has grown to the point that we host as many *R.E.C.* weekends as we do *Walks to Emmaus*. That's right. Beginning in 2000, and continuing in 2001, DaySpring hosts 5 of each. While the *Walk to Emmaus* remains our chief focus, our *R.E.C.* Weekends have brought the Good News of Jesus Christ to well over 800 men incarcerated in the county jails and prisons of Southern Indiana. And, we are hoping to make 2001 the year we host our first women's

R.E.C. weekend.

Those of you who have had the privilege of serving on one of these powerful weekends have experienced the effect it has on the residents who attend. If you believe that only God can change a man you will realize that we are taking a giant positive step toward reducing crime in our community and helping to rebuild the families of the offenders. The residents who attend our weekends are somebody's sons and daughters who have made bad choices in their lives and are in the process of paying for their mistakes. But make no mistake, they are all children of God.

Unlike the *Walk to Emmaus* an *R.E.C.*

weekend is financed entirely by the \$80 contributions made by team members, offerings at *R.E.C.* candlelights and your donations. Each of the facilities furnishes one or more meals to the team; but, neither the residents nor the facilities contribute a dime to the general funding. We need your help.
