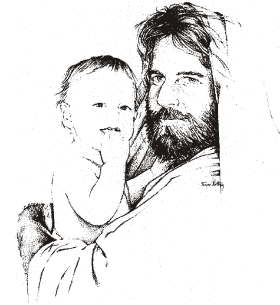

Rev. Don Cline, DaySpring Community Spiritual Director

I have, for the last seven months, been the minister at Orleans United Methodist Church. I have been married to Jean for twenty-seven years and have a daughter, Heather, who is a senior at Ball State University and Adrienne, who is sixteen and a junior at Orleans High School. Before coming to Orleans UMC I was the pastor at Lincoln Hills UMC for three and a half years and a student pastor at Pleasant Grove in Charlestown, Indiana for five years. I graduated from Asbury Theological Seminary and am an ordained elder in the United Methodist Church. 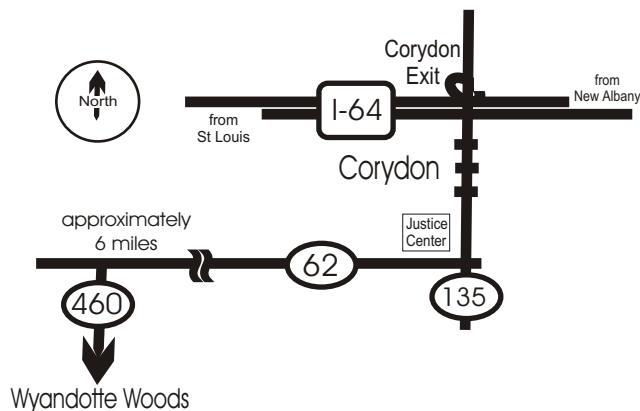

Take I-64 W to the Corydon Exit. Turn right (south) onto Hwy 135. Follow Hwy 135 through town and turn right onto Hwy 62, at the traffic signal just past the Justice Center. Follow Hwy 62 for approximately 6 miles. And, turn left onto Hwy 460. Follow Hwy 460 into the park and on to the retreat center. **You will be required to pay to get into the park** (around \$2.00).
