Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ Jesus,

The day I left my Emmaus walk, I knew God would call me to serve within this community. But never, NEVER in my wildest dreams did I imagine it would be behind bars!

My husband, Larry, and I gave an REC marriage talk several years ago. I recognized the look on the faces of those men . . . the look of being lost, seeking something but not knowing what, and hurting inside because there was a void that couldn't be self fulfilled. I knew they wanted forgiveness, peace and joy in their lives, because they said so. They were just like me . . . before I met Jesus and invited him in as Savior and Lord of my life. After I saw and heard the hearts of those men, I was hooked forever on REC. At that time, REC was only available to men.

A long time ago God placed a special passion in my heart for helping hurting women, especially women with children, and most especially single moms. And now He has opened the doors in Southern Indiana a second time for this Community to reach some of those women most desperately in need of Him.

I believe if we, through the power of the Holy Spirit, can reach these women and they accept Christ, the world can truly change. Think what a difference Jesus will make in just her own life once she's released and goes back into the "real world."

More importantly, if we can reach the moms and someday-moms, what a profound and positive influence there will be on the children. And if the children experience that positive influence of Christ in their lives . . . well just imagine! Did you know that the children of inmates are eight times more likely to end up in jail than other

welcome. Agape can be dropped off at Northside Christian Church in New Albany on Wednesday (4/17) between 5:30 & 7:00 p.m. at the Information Center or at the Hampton Inn in Corydon on Thursday (4/18) after 6:00 p.m. or Friday (4/19) before 1:00 p.m. PLEASE NOTE: Harrison County jail requires there be NO FRUIT of any kind. This includes raisins in cookies, etc.

Early in the planning stages of this REC, God brought this Scripture to mind. "You must speak my words to them, whether they listen or fail to listen, for they are rebellious." (Ezekial 2:7) Pray and ask if any of these words are being spoken to you. Is He asking you to attend Candlelight, write a letter, bake some oatmeal cookies (with walnuts but NO raisins) (smile)? Or is He simply asking you to pray? You will bless these women, their children and our Father with your yes.
