Washington County REC #1 replaced by Special Program

As the old saying goes, "God works in strange and wonderful ways." Earlier this month we got a first-hand taste of those strange and wonderful ways when it became necessary to cancel the REC scheduled for the Washington County Jail, in Salem, IN.

Because the facilities in Washington County are considerably smaller than what we are used to working with the original plan was to erect a tent and hold the REC in the outside gym. However the Sheriff decided that area was far too unsecure for the number of people that would be coming and going. So, the REC was reassigned to the library, which was a small room that is also regularly used for church services.

The size and layout of this room would only have allowed three tables, at the most – and would still be cramped with Wheat and Music Teams. After much prayer and attempts at rearranging things Lay Director, Tim Underwood and Spiritual Director, Bob Campbell came to the painful conclusion that a traditional REC was simply not feasible in those quarters. But rather than totally abandon the mission they put their heads together and created an abbreviated version of the traditional program in which five talks were offered, followed by open discussion by the Residents in attendance and a very small team.

As a demonstration of our dependence on prayer speakers were prayed in and

prayed out in the front of the room for all to witness. During the breaks between the talks musicians played, everyone sang and drinks and snacks were inhaled by all.

Residents were seated on benches around the walls and in the center area, which allowed for 26 attendees.

Everything was far less formal but one thing didn't change... Jesus showed up just as always. More than two thousand years ago He promised us that where two or more are gathered in His name there He would be also. And He is still faithful to His promise, today.

We, the DaySpring Community, should be grateful to God for providing us with men of experience, vision, creativity, and courage, like Tim Underwood and Bob Campbell. It would have been extremely difficult for any of us to make that difficult call to cancel an entire REC. But because they possessed servant hearts and were willing to open themselves to the will of the Holy Spirit they took the reins and fulfilled God's purpose in Washington County.

After the *Means of Grace* talk was given an alter call was offered. As a result of this program 13 men either made first-time commitments or rededications of their lives to Jesus. The original plan for an REC in the outside gym would not have included enough space for 13 men. God truly does work in strange and wonderful ways.
