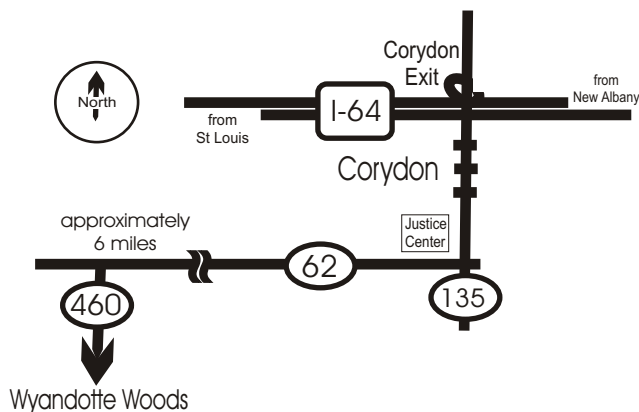

Follow Hwy 62 for approximately 6 miles. And, turn left onto Hwy 460. Follow Hwy 460 into the park and on to the retreat center. **You will be required to pay to get into the park** (around \$2.00).
