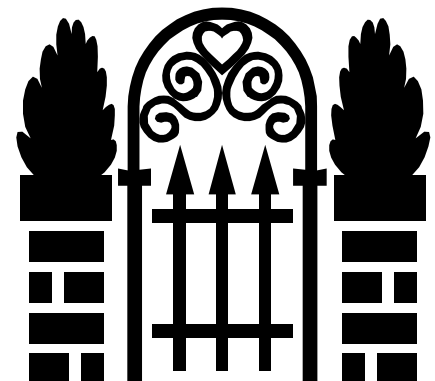

R.E.C. Update and Wish List

2004 promises to be another special year for the Day Spring Residents Encounter Christ ministry.

In 2003 we hosted nine great weekends for the men and women of the Clark, Floyd and Harrison County jails and for the men in the Washington County jail and the Madison Correctional Facility. What a year it was! And we, of the REC Board of Directors, would like to take this opportunity to express our gratitude to Bob Ash who served as Board Chairman and whose spirit has been the spirit of REC during the four years he served on the Board.

Board members for 2004 are Larry Cozine (Chairman), Dan Anderson (Chairman-Elect), Allan Miles (Treasurer), Carol Dougherty (Secretary), Mark Fernihough (Spiritual Director), Jane Lincoln (Clergy), Rod McGavock (Layperson), Ralph Wiseman (Layperson), and Carol Dobson (Layperson).

But time changes. Just before the annual Christmas Dinner in Madison we learned that the facility would be changed from a minimum-security institution for men to a medium-security institution for women. As most of you know REC in Southern Indiana was dedicated entirely to that facility for the first three years of its ministry. And we have continued to host two weekends each year and our annual Christmas Dinner there ever since. In time, we will be allowed to come back for women's REC's but, we will miss the men. Praise the Lord for the awesome experiences residents there have had as they have encountered Christ.

In 1996 we hosted our first REC weekend in a county jail at the Clark County Jail in Jeffersonville. As we prepared for the

Clark Co. Women's REC #2 and Men's REC #8 we learned that the gyms were being demolished to make way for the new jail expansion there. Fortunately we were able to exchange these dates and teams with the Floyd County Jail and continue our preparation as if nothing had changed. Again, we owe all praise to Jesus.

On a high note we have been invited to host a mini-REC at the Orange County Jail in Paoli. So we have temporarily lost four and gained one. God just keeps moving forward.

During our past couple of years we have been experimenting with things that would improve our presentations and our overall impact on the residents to whom we minister.

We have twice borrowed the PowerPoint Laptop and projector from the Emmaus Community and have found it a real bonus because it focuses everyone's attention to the front of the room and allows us to use graphics and backgrounds to emphasize points. But we feel that it is counterproductive to both organizations to continue borrowing this equipment, since out use contributes to the natural wear and tear. So we have resolved to forgo the benefits of PowerPoint until we can get a set of our own. Then the total Community will have a backup set should either of them fail.

Also, we would like to give each resident a full Bible to keep and study. We currently give each resident a New Testament (in English or Spanish as needed) and a Prayer of Jabez. The Prayer of Jabez books are provided to us free of charge, but we pay approximately \$2.00 each for each New Testament. Full bibles, with the same type of study guides will cost approximately \$10.00 each.

Order quantity that provides the break in price is 500 units. In other words, it would increase the cost of an order from \$1000 per order to \$5000 per order.

Because REC is dependent on contributions and because we strive to be servants of His will, we are laying our fleece before the Lord. Several people have shown an interest in making contributions to the REC ministry but were not certain what we needed. We can purchase a new video projector, a spare bulb and a laptop computer for approximately \$3,500. And we believe this is an excellent price.

We need a total of approximately \$4000 per order (about every two years) to switch from New Testaments to full Bibles.

Therefore, in accordance with the signed *Letter of Agreement*, it is with great pleasure that The DaySpring Emmaus Board announces the triennial training arrangement for 2004. Our regional representative, Cathi Eberly will train Board members only on Friday, July 16th. The following day, Saturday, July 17th Cathi Eberly will be conducting an all day training session for the entire DaySpring Emmaus Community.
