- 4) Share your computer skills: Are you a computer whiz? Lay Directors are always looking for persons with PowerPoint knowledge for Agape Teams. Would you be willing to offer a training session to members of the community who want to learn PowerPoint? Could you help with the website? - 5) Be a team member: If you've never been asked to be part of a walk team, it's probably because we don't have your current information on a "SERVICE SHEET". If you are willing to help in this area and haven't been asked, see number two on the list!
- 6) Work behind the scenes: We need members who are willing to help load and unload the supply trailers at the walks. Would you like to be part of the team that makes sure everything gets in the right place at the walks and back on the trailers at the end? Do you have the ability to haul the trailers if necessary?
