

# President's Letter

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

These revisions created some fear that some clergy would be ineligible to work our walks. First, I want you to know we love all of our clergy and are so thankful for all they do for DaySpring as well as the Southern Indiana spiritual community as a whole. Second, I want to make sure you are aware we are not being picked on. This is an issue that Emmaus communities across the world are dealing with, which probably would not have even arisen if there were not issues somewhere. And lastly, I want to reassure you that your board has been and is working very hard to make this a non-issue for DaySpring. The Upper Room creates guidelines to help insure the Emmaus Walk maintains credibility and legitimacy in all the communities where these fantastic spiritual events occur. The board is simply taking the strides, which are mostly some paperwork hoops, to insure this credibility and legitimacy and to insure we are fulfilling our obligations, expectations and agreements with each of you as DaySpring members, the southern Indiana spiritual community as a whole, the Upper Room, and the all the other Emmaus communities across the world.

In closing I just want to thank you for your support of all the efforts of your board and ask for your continued prayers for the board as well as our DaySpring community. Please continue to be in prayer for the upcoming walks, the pilgrims, the lay directors and all the teams. Keep an eye open for the upcoming walk dates and candlelight locations, as well as the information about this year's picnic. We look forward to seeing each of you at our upcoming activities, and I pray you are blessed in all you do everyday.

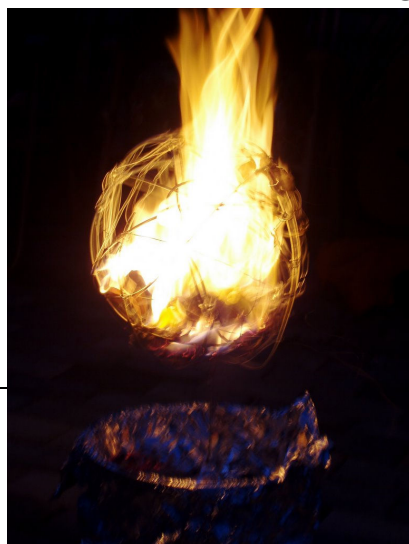

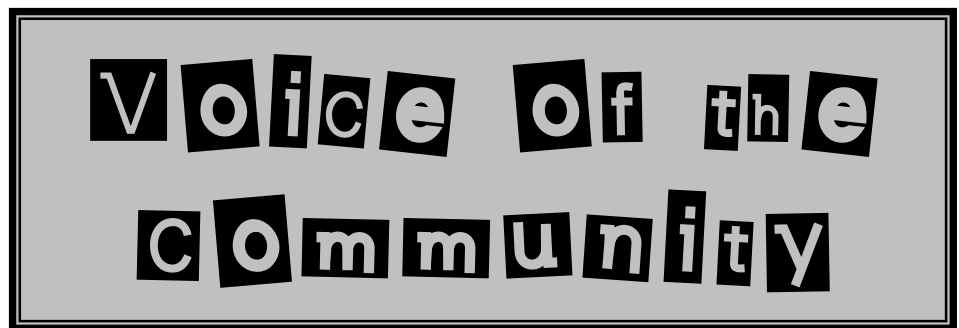
