COMMUNITY LAY DIRECTOR'S LETTER

This is my first letter to you as Community Lay Director. I am humbled to serve the community in this way, and looking forward to this next year. I want to say many thanks to George Browning as the outgoing CLD. George will continue to serve on the board for another year. As of August 1st, we did just say goodbye to several board members and they are: Carol Shrewsbury, Shell Law, Michael May, Donnie Peacher, Lynn Finn and Brent Cox. Thank you all and thank you for all you do for this Community. It was a blessing and honor to serve with each of you. This, of course, means we have welcomed some brand new board members. They are: David Riley, Frank Heinz, Shelley Leffler, Tonye Rutherford, Mike Scroggins and Stacy Kampschaefer.

As I sit writing this letter, it is the first day of fall, and what a beautiful day it has been! This is one of my favorite times of year. My summer flowers are still in bloom and my hummingbirds haven't left yet for warmer weather, and I love being able to have my windows open and have the fresh breeze in my house! I am praying that we will be blessed with this kind of weather on the upcoming Walk weekends.

I want to share with you something interesting that we have learned: Through a contact by someone from the Western Sydney (Australia) Emmaus Community we have found out that Western Sydney is holding their walks on the same weekends as ours. Also, both communities were holding a team meeting on Saturday, September 21. With so many Emmaus Communities around the world, I am sure this happens more often that we know, but it is pretty neat to KNOW it is happening. Our teams have already started praying specifically for the Western Sydney Walks, and I would ask that you add this to your prayer list as well. We have contacted Western Sydney about the teams exchanging agape letters to be read in the conference room. Wouldn't it be special if they could coordinate so that the letters were being read to the pilgrims at the same time? (Sydney is 14 hours ahead of us.) To think of that truly gives me goose God bumps!

Now, a little business. First of all, WE NEED YOUR CURRENT CONTACT INFORMATION! Dayspring Emmaus is now using an online database. All of the information we have from the service sheets and walk rosters that we had on file was transferred into this database. Lay Directors are using this database to put together their teams, and I keep hearing report after report that the contact information is no good. This has happened in a couple of ways. One is that the person who set up our account spent countless hours of his own time manually typing this information into the computer. There are over 4,500 entries, and he is only human, so there are inevitably some mistakes. It was a huge task and the board was blessed beyond belief for this act of service! The main reason is simply that so many people have had phone number and email changes, and we don't have that information. Many people have gotten rid of their landlines, and with the recent insight change to TWC, I know many email addresses are out of date. We also recently sponsored a Minister's Appreciation Dinner, and many of the mailed invitations were returned for incorrect addresses. So, PLEASE, PLEASE, get us your current information. We will also add you to our email list, unless you request otherwise, which means you will receive prayer requests, notifications of Emmaus events and gatherings, and other Emmaus related information. This is the best way to keep up on what is going on in the Community.

You may get your information to us by

1. Going to the website at www.dayspringemmaus.org and going to the Contact Us page. Fill in your information, put a note in the comment box that you are updating or adding your info. (The form requires you to fill in an email address, so if you do not want to be on the email list, please also note this in the comment box.)
2. Filling out a new service sheet and either mail it in or turn it in to a board member at any Gathering or event.
3. We will have a clipboard at Gatherings and events for you to give us your information.

Next and last, many of you have already heard this, but starting with the Spring 2014 walks, anyone who wants to sponsor a pilgrim will have to attend a one-time training session. I have heard from several people that feel they do not need this, and perhaps they do not. However, with so many people in our Community, it is not feasible to (and who would want to be the one to have to?) pick and choose who may or may not need training. This is why it will simply be required of everyone. It is in the form of a 20 – 30 minute PowerPoint presentation. I know everyone has a busy schedule, but please consider this an additional act of agape to provide the best experience possible for the pilgrims. We spend time making snack, pillow or table agape, we spend time in prayer, we spend time serving meals and going to the walk events, surely we can take another 30 minutes to do something that is for the best interest of future pilgrims. To make this as easy as possible for everyone, this training session will be made available conveniently and frequently. Several churches have either already hosted a training session, or have them on their calendars. You can request to schedule a training at your church by contacting Jamie Hayden at jhayden333@yahoo.com. Training will also be presented as a part of the follow-up for the fall walks.

Follow-up is on Saturday November 2nd, so mark that date on your calendars. Come welcome our newest pilgrims into the Community, share a meal, hear some music and Fourth Day testimonies, and get your Sponsorship Training! (Details & a list of what to bring for the pitch-in follow in this newsletter.)

Please continue to pray for the board as we go forward for the next year. We want everything we do, every decision we make, to be for God's glory. Of course, continue to be in prayer for the teams and pilgrims of Walks #117 & #118. I look forward to seeing you at the Candlelights and Closings – let's show the pilgrims the love of this amazing Community and our Savior, Jesus Christ!

Before it becomes a butterfly, a caterpillar goes through a growth stage during which it is called a "chrysalis." On the surface it may not look like much is happening, but the delicate chrysalis process changes the fuzzy caterpillar into an awesome butterfly with wings of intricate designs and intense colors. The chrysalis process symbolizes how Christ can transform you into something beyond your dreams. It happens when you grow beyond yourself, opening your life to Jesus' power and love.

"Chrysalis" is the name chosen for the youth and young adult version of The Walk to Emmaus, its parent movement, because it symbolizes the spiritual growth that is essential between adolescence and adulthood. That growth is as crucial for youth as the cocoon is for the caterpillar. It is that precious time of nurturing a person's faith for discipleship.

Chrysalis Flights (for 10th through 12th graders) and Journeys (for young adults, ages 19-24) are three-day events. This three-day spiritual renewal time provides an opportunity for you to learn more about faith, to experience Christian love and support, and to make new faith commitments. The point is to inspire, challenge and equip you for a closer friendship with Christ and for Christian action at home, church, school, and community.

Chrysalis lifts up a way for you to enjoy Christ's friendship and love and to be Christ's friend and partner in the world. The three days focus on God's grace, your experience with Christ as friend, what it means to be the body of Christ, and giving love to a needy world.

DID YOU KNOW ?

If someone completes a Chrysalis Flight or Journey weekend, they are still eligible to go on an Emmaus walk unless they have worked an Emmaus walk. If you have put off sponsoring a young adult on a Chrysalis Flight or Journey because you want them to experience an Emmaus walk, you don't have to wait.

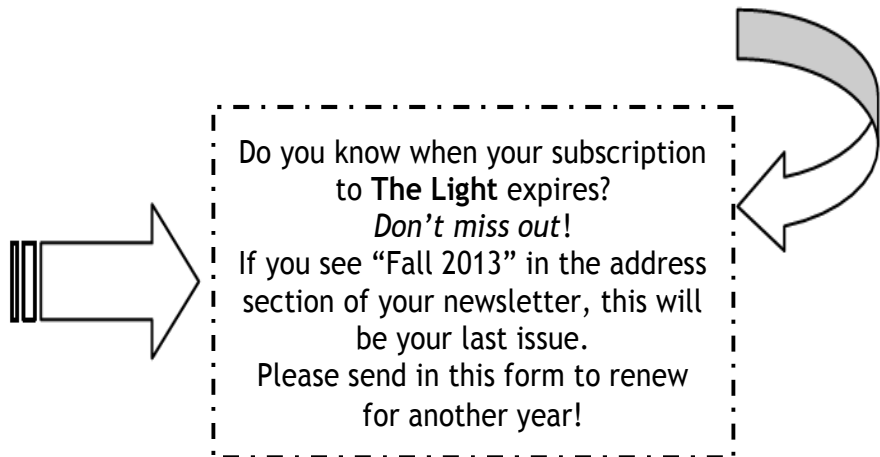
Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

What is a Reunion Group?

The Emmaus group reunion is a small accountability group of at least two to 12 persons who have usually participated in the three-day Walk to Emmaus and who want to continue their pursuit of a life lived wholly in the grace of God. These small follow-up groups help pilgrims translate the message conveyed on the Walk to Emmaus weekend into a daily walk with Christ. With the regular support of a few faithful friends, the gift of God's love in Jesus Christ becomes a lifestyle of Christian discipleship through the threefold discipline of piety, study and action.

Group reunions meet at regular times, usually weekly for an hour. The meeting consists of persons' sharing the stories of their walk with Christ during the past week. Members listen to one another, celebrate the grace of God in each person's life, and reinforce each one's core commitment to living in union with Christ in all facets of daily life. Members express that reinforcement through gentle accountability, encouragement, and support of one's stated discipline and plans.
