COMMUNITY LAY DIRECTOR'S LETTER

"For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God." – 1 Corinthians 1:18 (NIV)

It seems that even more so in our country, people are more vocal about their hostility against Christ and His followers. They don't want to hear and they don't want us to interfere. The flames of their agenda are being stoked by a media who are like-minded. We are considered fools for our beliefs. But the Scripture reminds us that the cross is foolishness to them. We should not be surprised or offended. Instead, we should be the salt and light that Jesus has called us to be – sharing the message of the cross boldly as it is the power of God. We have just celebrated Easter, and as Easter people, we need to live as such even as the days are dark.

Pilgrims of Walks #111 and 112, I want to again welcome you as part of the DaySpring Emmaus Community. Seven individuals are on the ballot, and you are asked to vote for no more than five. There are two opportunities for voting. The first is by using the ballot included in this newsletter, and mailing it. The second is by voting at the next Gathering on May 4 at Park Memorial UMC. Whichever way you choose, you may only vote one time.

May God's richest blessings be upon you during this springtime and throughout the rest of the year.
