### Sponsorship Update

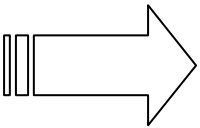

As part of the application process, a new **“Release of Claims and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, Indemnity, and Other Agreements and Acknowledgements”** must now accompany the application/registration form to attend a walk. The liability release can be downloaded from the Dayspring web site ([www.DaySpringEmmaus.org](http://www.DaySpringEmmaus.org)) along with the application/registration form.

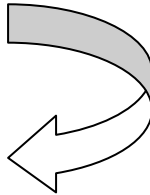
In order for the liability release to be valid, it must be notarized before submitted. Most banks have a notary on staff that would be able to provide this service free of charge.
